Quiet Reflection and Journaling • May 11, 2024

Offering a Cup of Cold Water Sharing His Love and Living Water with Those Who Thirst

During these times of quiet reflection, we're asking two basic questions: What do I want to ask of the Lord, and what does He want to say to me at this time. We then wait, listening for His response. Let these questions guide your reflections and help you identify the things you want to process with the Lord. Take time to quiet your mind. Ask the Lord to help you hear what He is saying, and to give you freedom to pour out whatever is on your heart.

- 1 Chris's message 507 Through my friend, who led me to God's living water, when I didn't know I was thirsty, I learned to feast on His Word and give away what I had been given. He called me to help others receive inner healing the power of His Word in making us whole.
 - ~ Ask the Lord to show you if there are experiences in your life that He wants to use in drawing others to Himself.

 \sim Is there a way in which the Lord wants to draw you closer to Him? (Is there anything blocking that nearness with Him?)

- 2 Diane's message 80 What situation(s) do you see the Lord is using in your life that is making you thirst for living water so that you say, like David: O God, you are my God, earnestly I seek you: my soul thirsts for you?
 - $\sim\,$ How do you see that the Lord may be using this season in your life so you can offer a cup of cold water to others?

 How is the Lord calling you to cry out in the night for the lives of your children (biological or those He's put in your path)? (Lam. 2:19)

- 3 Paul's message 80 Hear the Samaritan woman's story as it might be spoken to you:
 - ~ What might Christ's love through the Spirit be guiding you to see about where you have sought relieve for your thirst, "husbands" you have sought for comfort?

 \sim How can you, through word and deed, be offering a cup of love, light and truth to those around you even as you cry out your own need to the Father?

4 – Ask the Lord: Show me if there is an area in my life that You want to bring to light today, anything in me that You want to "water" or change in some way.

John 4:7-15

⁷ A woman from Samaria came to draw water. Jesus said to her, "Give me a drink."⁸ (For his disciples had gone away into the city to buy food.) ⁹ The Samaritan woman said to him, "How is it that you, a Jew, ask for a drink from me, a woman of Samaria?" (For Jews have no dealings with Samaritans.)

10 Jesus answered her, "If you knew the gift of God, and who it is that is saying to you, 'Give me a drink,' you would have asked him, and he would have given you living water." ¹¹ The woman said to him, "Sir, you have nothing to draw water with, and the well is deep. Where do you get that living water? 12 Are you greater than our father Jacob? He gave us the well and drank from it himself, as did his sons and his livestock." 13 Jesus said to her, "Everyone who drinks of this water will be thirsty again, ¹⁴ but whoever drinks of the water that I will give him will never be thirsty again. The water that I will give him will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life."15 The woman said to him, "Sir, give me this water, so that I will not be thirsty or have to come here to draw water."
