WALKING WITH THE SPIRIT → His Light in Our Hearts and Lives

Quiet Reflection and Journaling, October 12, 2024

During these times of quiet reflection, we're asking two basic questions: What do I want to ask of the Lord, and what does He want to say to me at this time. We then wait, listening for His response. Let these questions guide your reflections and help you identify the things you want to process with the Lord. Take time to quiet your mind. Ask the Lord to help you hear what He is saying, and to give you freedom to pour out whatever is on your heart.

- The value of this journaling time is that we can open the door to these subtopics and along the way, highlight what we want to revisit in the days to come. These questions are drawn from our topic and from the scriptures included on this page.
- 1. In the King James version Galatians 5:1 says: *Standfast therefore in the liberty, wherewith Christ has set us free and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.*

Ask the Lord to shed His light on any place you may feel entangled or in bondage.

2. As you consider Galatians 5:16 & 25 ask the Lord if He is calling you forth to walk with Him in new ways in the Spirit.

3. Are you in a situation where you are witnessing, interceding, or ministering? Do you feel 'the need for fresh equipping, and zeal as you share His heart and love with others?

16 So I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. 17 For the flesh desires what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the flesh. They are in conflict with each other, so that you are not to do whatever you want. 18 But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law....

²² But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law. ²⁴ Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. ²⁵ Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit.

13 But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all the truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come. 14 He will glorify me because it is from me that he will receive what he will make known to you. 15 All that belongs to the Father is mine. That is why I said the Spirit will receive from me what he will make known to you."

6. Is there anything else you want to ask of the Lord today, or something the Lord wants to say to you that isn't part of today's topic?	Ask Him to bring to light any assumptions or perceptions embedded in your heart and story that are not true. What is true that He would write in place of what is written there?
	Invite the Lord to minister to you in the quiet. Whether with words or in the simple awareness that He is present with you, let Him "restore your soul" in whatever way you need. You may want to journal and reflect on this time later.
